Falmer Stadium construction immortalised in oils

FALMER Stadium has been immortalised in oil by a local painter.

Lewes-based artist Julian Bell has unveiled his new painting, *The Construction Of Falmer Stadium* April 2010. It will go on display later this month.

Mr Bell, who is the grandson of

Bloomsbury painter Vanessa Bell and a cousin of the writer Virginia Woolf, sketched the stadium from land close to the University of Brighton campus.

He then completed the painting in oils on primed board.

Mr Bell said: "Initially I didn't want it to be built there but now that it

has been built, I am fascinated by it. It's a very bold design that transforms the landscape."

The picture will be on display at St Anne's Gallery in High Street, Lewes, between June 19 and June 27.
